Case Management & Financial Coaching Support for Formerly Incarcerated Job Seekers with Disabilities

The FAIR Program provides free financial coaching and case management services to formerly incarcerated people with disabilities to assist them in achieving their employment, financial, and reentry goals. See the reverse for a list of FAIR services.

Eligibility



- Released from jail or prison within the last 10 years, or will be within the next three-months;
- Live in or plan to live in Orleans or Jefferson Parish;
- Be between 18 and 70;
- Have a disability (or significant health condition); AND
- Be working or interested in looking for a job.
